## **Code of Conduct**

Members and guests of the Rideau Curling Club are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will reflect positively upon them, other members and guests, the Rideau Curling Club and the community, in general. Their responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

### **General Behavior**

Protecting the name of the Rideau Curling Club, on and off the ice

Exemplifying a high sense of personal honor and integrity

Using only socially accepted language

Respecting drinking and driving laws (no excessive consumption of alcohol)

Showing respect for rights and property of others

Observing Club rules and regulations, provincial and federal laws, and city ordinances

### **Participants Code of Ethics**

Displaying good sportsmanship before, during, and after each curling game

Conducting themselves in an honorable manner both on and off the ice

Never knowingly breaking a rule, but if they do, divulging the breach

Taking no action that could be interpreted as an attempt to intimidate or demean opponents, teammates, or officials

Interpreting the rules in an impartial manner, always keeping in mind that the purpose of the rules is to ensure that the game is played in an orderly and fair manner

Being held accountable for any costs that accrue due to their behavior on and off the ice

Humbly accepting any penalty that the Rideau Curling Club deems appropriate if they are found in violation of the General Behavior, Participants Code of Ethics, or Rules of the Game
